1. Dr. Young's Pond Berry Farm (639-6360), 2 miles east of Angier on Hwy. 210 (take Old Stage Rd. to 210 and turn right) Blackberries and blueberries June, July and August

2. Ken's Produce & Garden Center (779-4765) 3175 Benson Hwy. 5 miles south of Garner on Hwy. 50. Butterbeans, peas, pumpkins, collards, herbs, hanging baskets, bedding and vegetable plants, shrubbery, trees, perennials. Produce market open Mon.-Sat. 8 am - 6 pm, Sun. 1-5 pm Corn Maze & special events summer & fall.

5. Chris Hunt / Arnella Hunt Hunt's Strawberry Farm – (266-1619) Mon-Sat 8-8 / Sun 11-5 mid Apr-early June Strawberries, seasonal fruits & vegetables 4505 Watkins Rd., Raleigh - 401N to Mitchell Mill Rd; go 2.5 miles, turn right onto Watkins Rd.: we are on the left 1.5 miles

6. Fletcher Wrenn & Mitchell Wrenn

(269-9781) 5078 Brantley Rd., Zebulon (2 miles east of Mudcat Stadium off old Hwy 264) Strawberries (u-pick or we pick), tomatoes (April 15th)and cucumbers, cantaloupes, butterbeans picked & shelled, sweet corn & cabbage, squash, broccoli, bell peppers and a variety of produce and nursery stock.

Wrenn's Greenhouse (4 miles east of Zebulon off Alt. 264 on Brantley Rd.) Open Mon. - Sat., 7 am - 7 pm, Sun. 1-6.

7. Loyied & Barbara Norris (772-4906) WE PICK ONLY - Large assortment of vegetables, melons & cut flowers. Veggies and flowers available April-Nov. (in season). Blueberries - July. Call for directions.

8. Buckwheat Farm - Karma Lee (303-0339) or (244-6947) Strawberries - mid April to mid-June. Blueberries - Late June to July, Homemade Jam, Jelly year around. Honey - Late July until supply lasts. From Apex, take Hwy 64 West. Take Kely Road Exit (just past 540 overpass). Keep right (to cross over Hwy 64). Travel south on Kelly Road 2 miles. Turn right on Holland Road.

Field is on the left or take Rock Quarry Rd. out
of Raleigh, we are located 4 miles from Walnut
Creek Amphitheater.

10. Kirk Farms (217-0411)

Strawberries – April-June, cabbage – May-June, sweet corn, butterbeans, field peas, watermelons & cantaloupes – June-July, pumpkins – Oct, Christmas Trees – Thanksgiving Day-December. Located off Poole Road, 6 miles east of 440 (exit 15) towards Wendell. From Hwy 70 – Auburn Knightdale Rd to Grasshopper, right on Grasshopper Rd to Bethlehem Rd, turn left on Bethlehem Rd. go to stop light at church and turn right on Poole. 8/10 mile on right. From Knightdale 1st Ave to Bethlehem Rd to Poole Rd. At church turn left on Poole Rd. 8/10 mile on right.

11. The Collard Patch

Hal Gurley – (919-556-5135)

Yellow & white sweet corn, purple hull peas, black crowder peas, butterbeans, old fashion six week peas, squash, tomatoes, string beans. Fall crops include collards, cabbage, turnip salad & broccoli. Call for picking times. Take 401North from Raleigh to Rolesville. Go through town approximately 1 mile and turn right on Pulley Town Road. We are located 7/10 of a mile on the left.

12. Porter Farms & Nursery Farm Market

3525 NC Hwy 42 – Willow Springs, NC (919-567-0504)

Strawberries, tomatoes, sweet corn, butterbeans, peas, okra, squash, peppers, cucumbers, pumpkins, ornamental gourds and mums. From Raleigh take I-40 East to Exit 312 – Hwy 42. Take Hwy 42 west 6½ miles to produce stand on right. Look for giant strawberry.

We also have a stand on the corner of Ten Ten Road and Lake Wheeler Road. You may call (919-567-0504) for more information.

13. Olde Country Mulch & Produce

8824 Poole Road – Knightdale, NC Fred Kirk – (291-6174) Bryan Kirk – (291-4350) Margaret Kirk – (427-9520)

Strawberries, (already picked) corn, cabbage, onions, blueberries, cantaloupes, watermelon, cabbage, cucumbers, okra, field peas, old fashioned butter, milk, old fashion candies, jams, jellies, crafts, molasses, country ham, pumpkins (October) and Christmas trees and wreaths during November & December along with collards and turnip salad. Coming in 2014, tomatoes. From Exit 15 Poole Rd east 6.5 miles on the right. From US 264 Bypass, Smithfield Rd south to Poole Rd and turn right towards Raleigh, 1.2 miles on the left. From Garner Hwy 70 Auburn Knightdale Rd to Grasshopper Rd. right on Grasshopper to Bethlehem Rd. Turn left on Bethlehem to Poole Rd at the church; turn right − 1 mile on the right.

From downtown Apex take North Salem Street. Once it turns into Davis Drive, bear right onto Salem Church Road. From Cary take Old Apex Road, bear right onto Salem Church Road. 1223 Salem Church Road – Apex, NC
